

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

Assistance

The Enterprise Zone Program - Communities in Ohio may establish an Enterprise Zone that provides local officials with the ability to negotiate a tax incentive agreement with a prospective company. The Enterprise Zone Agreement is a contract between the community and the company. This contract must be executed prior to any portion of the project beginning. The rate and term of the tax exemption are negotiated between local officials and the company.

Economic Development Grant - The JobsOhio Economic Development Grant was created to promote economic development, business expansion, and job creation by providing funding for eligible projects in the State of Ohio. Grant decisions are based on a number of project factors, including but not limited to job creation, additional payroll, fixed-asset investment commitment, project return on investment, and project location.
